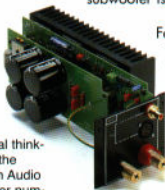
Now, by popular demand, Tabu by Gryphon offers the power amplifier section of the Tabu integrated amplifier in a two-channel version (the 2 x 100 Watts Two/OneHundred) and a three-channel version (the 2 x 100 Watts plus 1 x 150 Watts Three/OneHundred), featuring awesome 40,000 μ F per channel power capacitor banks for ample power reserves and rare C-core transformers (three times as costly as conventional toroidal types) with exceptionally tight windings. The Tabu power amplifiers incorporate the same thick, low-loss conductor tracks as the circuit board of the cost-no-object Gryphon Antileon power amplifier with a 105 μ m layer of copper on both sides.



More Channels, More Power

The Three/OneHundred power amplifier adds a third channel of significantly higher power. When used to power the left, center and right front speakers in a home theater system, the additional output power applied to the center channel provides a much more accurate match for the distribution of energy in motion picture soundtracks.

The Three/OneHundred is also ideal for three-piece loudspeaker systems with satellites and a subwoofer. The higher current draw of the subwoofer is easily handled by the 150 Watt channel.



For serious home theater installations, we recommend a Three/OneHundred for the front and a Two/OneHundred for the rear. If a subwoofer is used, then a pair of Three/OneHundred presents an effective solution.

For two-channel music systems, we recommend the PreOne preamplifier from Tabu by Gryphon as the ideal partner for the Tabu power amplifiers.

Future Proof

Because of its modular mainframe design, the Two/OneHundred power amplifier can be expanded and upgraded at any time to full three-channel operation, making it identical to the Three/OneHundred with 2 x 100 Watts plus 1 x 150 Watts.
