Enthusiasts familiar with the acclaimed musicality and advanced design philosophy of Gryphon Audio Designs will instantly recognize the sound, look and feel of the Century integrated amplifier from Tabu by Gryphon. Careful attention has been paid to component selection and interaction, circuit design, PCB layout, grounding, assembly and quality control in every phase of the design process.

The Century is essentially two independent mono devices for reduced crosstalk and minimal interchannel interaction. To minimize interference, the Century utilizes a separate power supply for all non-audio circuits. The short signal path employs extra thick copper traces on double-sided circuit boards and an absolute minimum of wiring. In addition to 4 conventional single-ended inputs with PCB-mounted gold-plated WBT phono sockets, a balanced input with PCB-mounted gold-plated Swiss Neutric XLR sockets is included to fully exploit signal transmission in the balanced mode for improved immunity to interference when using a source with balanced outputs. The mechanical design of the cabinet and assembly methods are all carefully calculated to provide a non-resonant environment for vibration-sensitive components, through mechanical grounding and decoupling of the transformers.



The full-function remote control included with the Century brings a new level of convenience and functionality to high end audio, making audiophile performance available at affordable cost and with minimal complexity. Flexible, modular design allows the user to purchase the Century in a line-level version or with an optional phonostage for LP playback. The phonostage module may also be added at a later date.
